

CADDIE TRAINING 2018

The Caddie Program has been around for more than 40 years and the underlying purpose has remained the same. Older girls can develop valuable leadership skills used to volunteer at volunteer-led day camps throughout our Council and at other events such as Service Unit Encampments. Caddie Training teaches outdoor skills, outdoor cooking, tent care, songs and games and communication skills. Most importantly girls have 'FUN'.

The pre-requisite for all Caddie Trainings is Program Aide Training. This is for girls in 6th-12th grade. Girls only need to take this training once. Listed below are the three levels of Caddie Training.

Junior Caddie – Girls that have completed Program Aide and currently in 6th grade and above

Caddies- Girls that have completed Program Aide, Junior Caddie Training and currently in 7th grade or above

Senior Caddie- Girls that have completed Program Aide, Junior Caddie, Caddie and currently at least 9th grade or above and attended a minimum of one day camp
