P.Y.N. (pronounced “pine”) Valley is an overnight camp for Girls in 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th grade. It was created specifically to bridge the gap between Pixie Valley (for grades K thru 3rd) and Piper Valley (7th thru 12th).

P.Y.N. Valley is a winter experience at Camp Elk River for registered Girl Scouts in River Valley Council. Check-in for the event starts at 11:30 on Saturday, February 17th and checkout will be completed by 1:00 on Sunday, February 18th.

Troops will be staying in heated cabins with the main meeting area in the Gray Koch Program Building. On this overnight, girls and adults will participate in one craft, one skill, one activity and one outdoor fun event. There will be a Talent Show put on by the girls attending camp. The cost for the camp is \$20.00 per girl/ \$18 per adult.

Once again, we will offer the option for a few of the troops (any grade level) to stay over on Friday night. There is very limited space available for this. If your troop should decide they would like to do this – it would be troop time only. No program activities will be provided. The cost would be an additional \$10.00 per adult/girl. You will be permitted to check in any time after 6:00 pm on Friday night.
